Bureau of Fire Protection Region III Bamban Fire Station Conducted Fire and Earthquake Drill in SMEAG

"Sa Pag-iwas sa Sunog, Hindi ka Nag-iisa" (In Fire Prevention, You Are Not Alone) Fire Chief Superintendent, Manuel G. Golino, Director for Fire Safety Enforcement at the Bureau of Fire Protection National Headquarters, said that this year's theme highlights the importance of cooperation in ensuring fire-safe and disaster-resilient communities. Golino emphasized that this year's fire prevention month campaign is not just about spreading awareness; it is about fostering a culture of proactive fire prevention and emergency preparedness.



Equipping communities with the knowledge and tools needed and ensuring that Bureau of Fire Protection's response mechanisms are updated, coordinated, and efficient, Golino highlighted that the responsibility for fostering a fire-safe community is a shared responsibility, emphasizing the BFP's commitment to continuously conduct and intensify activities, which aims to raise awareness leaving no citizen uninformed.

By virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 115-A, the month of March was declared as Fire Prevention Month, in response with the alarming increase of fire incidents happening across the country during this particular period, SMEAG Global School, Philippines in collaboration with BFP R3 Bamban Fire Station Fire and Earthquake Drill 2024 have been successfully participated by the SME-AG Academic Department, featuring the Nursery to Grade 12 students of the current academic year.
